<p><b>WHY CERTAIN PROGRAMS OR CAMP USES AT A FACILITY IS PERMITTED IN YELLOW PHASE, BUT THEY ARE NOT AVAILABLE FOR ALL?</b></p> <p>Pennsylvania Department of Health guidelines permit Chambersburg latitude to allow youth enrichment programs in facilities that are otherwise closed to the general public.</p>	<p><b>WHY ARE CERTAIN FACILITIES OPEN IN GREEN PHASE, BUT OCCUPANCY IS LIMITED?</b></p> <p>Pennsylvania Department of Health guidelines suggest that controlling the number of participants or the type of programming at a facility may keep participants safer.</p>
<p><b>WHY SOME FACILITIES ARE OPEN IN OTHER TOWNS BUT NOT IN CHAMBERSBURG?</b>                      Chambersburg is doing our best to make as many recreational opportunities available to as many participants as possible. We recognize that other towns may make different decisions. We are doing our best to follow both Pennsylvania Department of Health and US CDC guidelines, as they are released, and as the situation changes.</p>

Whenever a facility is to have limited capacity, a capacity number will be posted and enforced.

Rules such as face coverings and social distancing for the public will be strongly recommended; but are not laws.

No citizen will be denied access to a facility merely due to lack of face covering, as there are valid exceptions.

Citizens refusing to apply the guidelines of good hygiene and social distancing may be denied access in the future.

The Recreation Department warns citizens that it is not practical to enforce social distancing as a rule. Instead, the goal is public information, reminders, explanations, and if necessary, the banning of future participation.
